As with all modern libraries, we aim to be much more than just a repository of books (though that is important). In view of that aim we sponsor and facilitate a number of outreach programs in the communities we serve.

One such program is a CVITP (Community Volunteer Income Tax Program). We do income taxes for low income earners. To say this program has been, and continues to be a success is most definitely an understatement.

The number of users has doubled, tripled and quadrupled in the few years the program has been operated.

Many also qualify for other forms of government assistance they weren't aware of in the past such as Low Income Supplements, GST rebates, Disability Status, etc.
